Winter clothing

We also need children to wear warm clothes indoors as we will be keeping the building well ventilated even in colder months due to the current regulations.

Please also ensure all items are labelled so we can reunite them with the owners if they are separated from them.

Lunch update

We have completed our first week of trialling the new meals from Hungry Monsters. So far we have had Chicken Tikka Curry and Rice, Lasagne, Sausage Casserole, Fisherman's Pie and Mexican Minced Beef. We are encouraged to see that the children have been very willing to try these dishes and many have been enjoying the new menu. Children are encouraged to try the meals by staff but are also encouraged by seeing others eating as well. We will feed back to you regularly how your child has eaten. We are encouraging independence with regards to the children using their cutlery to feed themselves and this ties in with the EYFS and their development.

We appreciate that this is transitional period as children adjust to the new lunchtime routines. All children do have the opportunity to enjoy a mid-morning / mid-afternoon snack so will be able to eat during the day.
